Installation

1. Perform a fresh ProcessWire 3.x.xx install (recommended v3.0.62)
2. Unzip the downloaded template archive
3. Upload data to your FTP
 - a. Replace **site** folder on FTP with **site** folder from archive
4. Set/update Database
 - a. Open database used in fresh ProcessWire 3.x.xx install
 - b. Delete all tables
 - c. Import **database.sql** with default options
5. Open **site/config.php** on FTP
 - a. Change database information
 - b. Change the domain-name in last line to **your-domain.com**
 - c. Set permissions of **site/config.php** on FTP server to **440**
6. Access frontend
 - a. Open browser and navigate to **http://your-domain.com**
7. Access backend
 - a. Open browser and navigate to **http://your-domain.com/admin**
 - i. User: **admin**, Password: **havefun@dm1n**
 - **Make sure to change the admin password!!**

Usage

The template has been designed to enable maximal flexibility maintaining a uniform and consistent design across all pages. In order to achieve such a consistency, every page is built of predefined building blocks called sections. Each section has a common layout with variable, section-specific settings ensuring a uniform layout of the whole website. After creating a page, one can add limitless numbers of sections that will be sequentially included in the given order loading the page. The order of sections can be changed by drag and drop.
